Project NUMBERS & STATISTICS

Since project initiation, the Cancer Registry lists 962 Veterans newly diagnosed with cancer at the VA Northeast Ohio Healthcare System. Of those, 639 have been diagnosed with cancers associated with Agent Orange or Camp Lejeune water contamination exposures. 427 Veterans were identified as potentially meeting initial eligibility criteria based on their service history, and have been contacted to notify of their potential eligibility for additional healthcare and benefits. This number includes 135 Veterans diagnosed with bladder cancer within the last two years who were also sent mailers notifying them of the addition of bladder cancer to the presumptive list in Jan 2021.
