Monday March 21, 2022 • Transitioning from REDCap to <u>Microsoft</u> <u>PowerApps</u>

The RAI is an assessment of frailty--a global syndrome of physiological decline and loss of reserve marked by diminished cognition, strength, balance, and coordination. 
