
Questionnaire for Emergency Medicine Providers and Leadership on the Inclusion of Rehab Therapy Services in Emergency Departments

29 respondents completed the survey from 6 facilities between February and March 2020


Survey will be repeated in 2021 in February for all facilities with inclusion of PT or OT in ED care beginning January 2021 or earlier.






27 of 29 of these providers had some history of patient referral to Physical Therapy or Occupational Therapy


What types of patients / cases could rehab therapy services assist with, including assessment or treatment? (percentage of providers, N=29)




Please indicate whether you would support a standardized inclusion of rehab therapy in the ED for patients presenting with any of the following
